


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


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THE BASIC IDEA OF RISK ADJUSTMENT

EXAMPLES

57-year-old male with a Hx of COPD, Diabetes, OUD, Depression, Schizophrenia, homelessness and food insecurity 23-year-old female with no preexisting conditions, stable home, stable job, healthy diet, and robust exercise regimen



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
